Matt tiles might feel safer than gloss-finish tiles, but wet bathroom floors demand more. It's about how the tiles perform when exposed to water or even soap.

To avoid slips and falls in bathrooms, especially for elders and kids, choose floor tiles with a tested slip resistance rating like the R10 A rating. That's the key to ensuring bathroom safety.


