WHY TILES DESERVE A PLACE IN THE BEDROOM

Tiles may not be the first material that comes to mind for bedroom floors—but they absolutely should be. With today's versatile designs, tiles can deliver the cozy warmth of wood, the elegance of marble, or the calm of natural stone—while offering the everyday durability and maintenance-free convenience that busy homes need.

Bedrooms also have lower foot traffic compared to living rooms and kitchens, which means you don't need floors that are engineered for heavy usage. What you do need is a surface that sets the mood, complements your furniture, and creates a space that truly feels like yours.



MAKE EVEN A COMPACT BEDROOM FEEL MORE OPEN



Bedrooms in most homes range between 120 to 150 sq. ft. That might feel like a design limitation—but it's actually an opportunity. With larger-format tiles like 60 × 120 cm or 80 × 160 cm, you reduce grout lines, creating a more expansive and seamless appearance.

Even 60×60 cm tiles can work beautifully in tighter spaces when paired with the right finish. And since up to 70% of the floor is covered by furniture, the part you do see has an outsized impact on the feel of the room.



FOR WARMTH AND TEXTURE, WOOD-LOOK TILES ARE A TOP CHOICE




If you want your bedroom to feel restful and natural, wood-look tiles deliver. Unlike real wood, they don't scratch, absorb moisture, or require polishing—yet they offer the same richness and grain detail you'd expect from traditional flooring.

You can choose from:

- $-60 \times 120 \text{ cm}$
- 20 × 120 cm
- 20 × 100 cm plank tiles

Laid in brick or herringbone patterns, they bring instant visual interest and a handcrafted, cozy feel.







PREFER ELEGANT AND MINIMALIST? EXPLORE MARBLE AND STONE FINISHES

For those who prefer a more luxurious or understated aesthetic, marble-look tiles in soft neutral tones can turn a bedroom into a serene escape. Beige, grey, and off-white palettes offer timeless appeal and a calm, spa-like presence.

If you're after modern minimalism, tiles inspired by natural stone in Eden shades like light brown or cement grey offer quiet elegance without visual clutter.

Just as much as the design, the surface finish affects how your bedroom feels. For a soft, intimate atmosphere, satin matt is a go-to. It's warm underfoot and doesn't glare under lighting. Or, if you want something textured and earthy, rustic finishes bring subtle variation and touchable depth.

- ▼ Tile sizes like 60 × 120 cm create a more open, seamless look
- Use satin matt finishes for comfort underfoot

FOR A WARM, WOODEN LOOK:



- ✓ Choose wood-look tiles in 20 × 100 cm, 20 × 120 cm, or 60 × 120 cm formats
- Consider brick or herringbone layouts for added interest

FOR ELEGANT OR MINIMALIST BEDROOMS:



- Go with marble-inspired or stone-finish tiles in neutral shades
- Explore tones like soft white, cement grey, or warm beige

FOR FINISHES THAT WORK: -



- ✓ Satin matt = cozy, understated
- ✓ Glossy = bright, sleek, modern
- ▼ Rustic textures = characterful, tactile
